Park Development Application Local Governments - Public Hearing Announcement

PURPOSE: The Township of Middletown is seeking funding through the State of NJ Green Acres Program for improvements at Croydon Hall located at 900 Leonardville Road, Leonardo, NJ, near the intersection of Leonardville Road and Bryant Avenue in Middletown.

PROJECT SCOPE: The Township of Middletown proposes to create and improve the following facilities at Croydon Hall: renovate an existing heavily used baseball field into a modern, multi-use turf baseball field, as well as makes updates to the lighting system, and construct new pedestrian walking paths, fencing, dugouts, bleachers, a portable outfield fence, and a batting cage. This application includes the installation of a new synthetic turf.
