Roadwork & Detours

Lane Closures on Middletown Lincroft Road at GSP Overpass Starting 4/16

Starting on Monday, April 16th Middletown Lincroft Road at the GSP Overpass will have intermittent lane closures between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. Monday-Friday through April 20th.

Roadwork on Highway 35 Between Chapel Hill Road & Apple Farm Road

Highway 35 between Chapel Hill Road and Apple Farm Road will have lane closures between the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday from Monday, 4/16 through Friday, 4/20.

Roadwork on Kings Highway & Church Street

There is significant roadwork being done on Kings Highway and Church Street in preparation of the signalization of the roadway. Kings Highway will have lane shifts in place and Church Street will have intermittent closures between 9am and 4pm from Monday, 4/16 through Friday, 4/20. Detours will be in place to follow.
