



## Middletown Township Launches Customized 'Recycle Coach' Smartphone/Web App

Today, Middletown Township launched **Recycle Coach**, a free customized mobile and web application that contains garbage, bulk and recycling information. Residents can access collection schedules, events, and search acceptable recyclable materials. Alerts and reminders are also available via the app. You can download the free app from [iTunes](#) or the [GooglePlay](#) app store. You can also access it online [HERE](#).

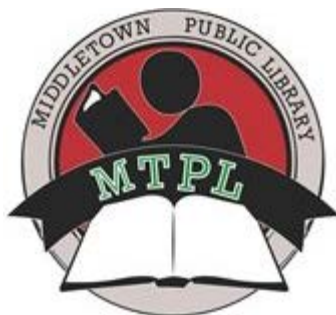
