In addition to providing an email address, you can include your address, cell phones and land line phones. Alerts may be sent by email, text or voice. Adding an address is recommended since some alerts can be targeted to a specific geographic area if necessary.



New! Notify Me

Receive e-mail notifications about the things that interest you. You can customize your notification list. Options include:

- community calendar
- meeting agenda and minutes
- news flash
- weekly newsletter

*Due to differences in security protocols, users need to register for alerts and notifications separately. You will receive two subscription confirmations - one for Alerts and one for Notify Me.
