2014 Summary of Complaints and Dispositions Received by the Middletown Twp. Police

In 2014, the Middletown Twp. Police Department Office of Professional Standards received a total of 11 complaints. 63.6% of the complaints came from citizen complainants. 36.4% were agency complaints.
