OUR PROGRAMS

Emergency Safe House: Survivors and their children are provided with temporary housing, counseling, case management, assistance in finding housing, and other supportive services regardless of gender identity and/or sexual orientation. Our Safe House includes pet-friendly rooms.

Domestic Violence & Sexual Violence Counseling: Individual short-term counseling, support groups, and financial empowerment workshops are available.

Domestic Violence Response Team: 180 trained advocates/counselors partner with municipal police to respond to the needs of domestic violence victims where needed, including police stations and hospitals.

Domestic Violence Liaison: connects survivors and families with the State's Child Protection Services and an experienced 180 Domestic Violence advocate improving services to high-risk families.

Culturally Specific Outreach Program: 180 extends its reach into minority and immigrant communities providing culturally relevant services to victims of domestic violence and sexual assault.

MONMOUTH COUNTY'S STRANGULATION/ SMOTHERING EVALUATION TEAM (SSET)

180 has worked with area police and hospitals to activate emergency assistance. If someone has been choked or strangled, call the police or go to the nearest hospital Emergency Room for assistance. The Monmouth County SSET includes Forensic Nurses, 180's Domestic Violence Response Advocates, and specially trained Law Enforcement Officers and offers 24/7 assistance to victims, including information, safety planning, and medical evaluations, as needed.



*All services are provided free of charge.

2NDFLOOR® Youth Help and Text line: a statewide service for children and teens to speak with a trained advocate to respond to crisis issues for the state's youth, including support about dating abuse, cyberbullying, sex/sexuality, and mental health issues including suicide.

Family Justice Center (FJC): a one-stop site for domestic and sexual violence survivors to meet all of their immediate needs – reducing their trauma and helping victims and their children expedite services with other agencies. Family court liaisons assist victims in Family Court, including applying for restraining orders, legal services, individual and group counseling, and court accompaniment.

Sexual Violence Response Team: trained advocates/counselors respond to the needs of sexual assault victims and their loved ones throughout the criminal justice system, in hospital emergency rooms, and during police and court procedures.

Online Sexual Violence Chat: our website feature allows sexual violence survivors to chat with a trained advocate.
